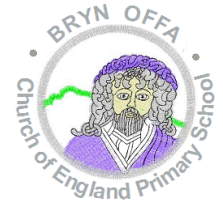

## **Class 2 Visit- Blue Planet Aquarium – Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2018**

This half term Class 2's has been 'Under the sea'. We have been completing work linked to this topic in all subject areas including: writing our own class non-fiction book about animals which live in the ocean in English; moving pictures in D&T; observational drawings in art; looking at the story 'Billy's bucket' in English; human and physical features of beaches in Geography, and we have also linked it to our Rainbow Fish dances in P.E.

At the beginning of our topic all the children asked a question that they wanted to find the answer to. We have been able to find the answers to most of them. However, some are still left unanswered and I thought that in order to find the answers to these final questions, and because the children have all worked incredibly hard this half term, it would be lovely to end our topic with a visit to Blue Planet Aquarium.

### **Visit details**

The trip will take place on **Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> December**. We will be leaving school at 9.15am and returning for the end of the normal school day. Your child will require a packed lunch for the visit with two drinks (not fizzy) all packed into a small rucksack or bag. Please ensure that your child is wearing their normal school uniform and sensible shoes. Please be aware that there is nowhere to store the children's bags/rucksacks whilst they are at the Aquarium so they will have to carry them with them during the visit.

### **Payment for the Visit**

The voluntary contribution for the trip will be £17.94 per pupil. This includes admission to the Aquarium (£7.95), an 'Under the Sea' demonstration (£1.10) and transport to and from the Aquarium (£8.89). Payment for this trip should be made electronically via the School Money online system and you will receive a text/email when the payment has been set up. Although this payment is voluntary, please note that if we do not receive sufficient contributions to cover the cost of the visit, it will not go ahead. It would be a terrible shame if we have to cancel the visit and support from all parents with payment would be really appreciated. Payment should be made by **Monday 26<sup>th</sup> November** where possible to allow us to ensure that the trip is viable. If you would like to discuss payment, please contact Miss Morris.

## School Packed Lunch

As you are aware, children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are eligible for a free school meal.
