Issues to be addressed by funding

- For a variety of reasons, some children need additional learning support in class, but do not qualify for it due to a special need.
- Some children have low self-esteem or emotional problems can't make the same progress as their peers.
- Some children do not have the same access as other children to activities which promote confidence and creativity.
- Some children do not have access to technology at home so do not have the opportunity to be supported in their learning at home so need to have the same access at school.
- Some children have lower attendance than children not in the Pupil Premium group

Academic Support	Small group and 1:1 tuition -38 hours per week of targeted intervention support - Detailed tracking of children for academic progress and attendance	£15 200	Specific barriers to learning and the best measures to overcome them are clearly identified. This helps to better match activities and strategies to pupil need and as a result accelerates progress.
Social and Emotional	- Mental health training for school staff - Learning mentor provision for the children during every lunchtime - 9 hours a week dedicated learning mentor support for social and emotional - No worries training for learning mentor and lead lunch supervisor - No worries training for rest of school staff	£400 £2000 £3600 £200 £200	Emotional barriers to learning are identified and pupils learn strategies to help them to overcome barriers and develop more resilience. Consequently pupils make better progress. More emphasis is placed on the attendance of the pupils and the learning mentor is used to remove the possible barriers to attendance. The overall anxiety levels of the children and their levels of resilience will improve.
Enrichment	- Supported places on school clubs. - Supported places on school trips and residential. - Music tuition - Additional resourcing	£1000 £1000	Pupils able to take part in educational visits, music lessons and after-school clubs. This helps to enrich pupils life experience and results in pupils having more self-worth, resilience and higher expectations.
