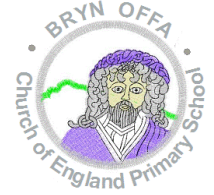
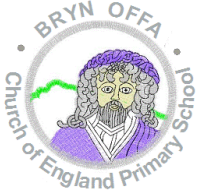

Road Closure Over Easter

Dear Parents

Most of you will be aware that there are some major roadworks taking place near the school over the Easter break to fit new water mains. There will be significant disruption over the Easter break, but our concern is with making sure the school is safe to access on Monday 29th April when the children return.

I have met with representatives from the company doing the work, and have been assured that they will have completed the work past the entrance and exit to our car park by the time the children return. They could give no more reassurance than this so it may be that sections of the road where parents normally park are not accessible until all the work is complete. There is also the possibility that there are more serious delays and they do not complete the work past our car park.

I have looked at the logistics of having multiple cars and buses with no way of turning around and consider the risks too high, so if we can't access and exit the car park I will need to fully or partially close the school. If I need to fully or partially close the school, parents will be informed on the text messaging service and a message will be on the school website.

I appreciate that if the roadworks don't go as planned it will be a massive disruption for all children and parents, but it could be especially unsettling for the Year 6 children on their run up to the Year 6 SATS. In order to minimise the disruption to the Year 6 children I have agreed that if necessary I will partially open the school just for the Year 6 children as long as they are able to be brought to school and collected by parents.

I wish you all a relaxing and enjoyable Easter break and hope to see you all on Monday 29th April for a normal start to the Summer Term.
