Welcome back!

We hope the children have enjoyed their first few days back with us. It has been great to see them all back again!

Name labels

Please ensure that your child's clothing, bag, water bottle and lunchbox/bag are clearly labelled with their name.

Water bottle reminder

Please can all children bring a water bottle into school with them as the water fountains are currently out of use.

Extra layers

Although we have the heating on, the classrooms may feel a little bit chilly at the moment as the windows are open to keep the classrooms well ventilated. The children are allowed to wear their coat in class if they are cold but coats can be a bit bulky to wear all day so please send your child in with an extra layer on or a fleece or similar if they need it.

School dinners

Please note that universal infant free school dinners are only available to children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. We do not use the pre-booking dinner system on School Money so you do not need to worry about pre-ordering dinners. The class teachers ask the children when they come in each morning whether they would like a school dinner or whether they have a packed lunch and then Miss Morris passes these numbers to the kitchen staff so they can prepare the necessary dinners. Miss Morris puts the dinners on to the system each Friday afternoon and the dinners are charged to each child's account. We would ask that dinner accounts are kept in credit please if possible rather than running into arrears. You will get a text/email if your child's account does go into arrears asking you to make a payment. Please note that we are only able to allow a maximum of 2 weeks' arrears before we have to consider stop providing meals so please try to keep your account in credit. Any credit on your account will continue to roll over until it is used.
