Dear Parent/Guardian,

'Year 6 Arthog Outreach Experience' 23rd, 24th and 25th June 2021

Due to the disappointment of the Year 6 Arthog experience being cancelled, I have secured a booking for another residential in late June. At the time of writing, residential trips are still not permitted by the government. However, following last week's roadmap, the lifting of restrictions should permit this trip to go ahead. If at the time of the residential we are still unable to take children away overnight, we will run this trip as three consecutive days of adventure but return to school each day. As soon as I know further details, I will let them know.

I have enclosed the proposed itinerary set out by Arthog Outreach for you to have a look through. Arthog Outreach is the company who provide the climbing, caving, canoeing and bushcraft experience for our Year 3 and 4 pupils. Their knowledge of the local environment is second to none and every instructor I have worked with from this company has been amazing. Whilst, it is a shame that we have had to cancel the Arthog trip, I am confident that this will more than make up for it and provide a memorable way to end your child's time with us at Bryn Offa.

The cost of the experience will be approximately £125. **We would like to ask for a non-refundable of £25.00 to be paid by Thursday 1st April, with the remaining balance due by Friday 11th June.**

In order to allow me to confirm numbers with Arthog Outreach, I would be grateful if you could complete the form over the page and return it to school by **Monday 22nd March**. Once we have these numbers, Miss Morris will set up the deposit payments on School Money for any children who were not booked to go on the original Arthog trip. In order to secure your child's place, this form needs to be returned to school please whether or not your child was booked on the Arthog visit.

Many of you will have already paid a deposit and the remaining balance for Arthog and if you would like your child to attend this residential, these monies will be transferred over and refunds made for any overpayments. Once we know the final cost of this new residential visit, Miss Morris will sort this for you.

Fingers crossed we will be able to take the Year 6 pupils away for a couple of nights and provide them with a positive experience in what has been an incredibly difficult time for these young people.
