## **Absence from School because of illness**

If your child is absent from school because of illness, please telephone or email us to let us know the reason before 9.30am on the morning of absence. If your child is absent for more than one day, please contact us each morning to keep us updated.

Please note that if your child is suffering from sickness or diarrhoea, they will need to remain off school for 48 hours after the last period of sickness or diarrhoea. This follows the Public Health England Guidance on Infection Control in Schools and Other Childcare Settings.

Can I please remind parents that children should not be running around the playground or playing with equipment at the end of the school day. Parents and guardians should be leaving the school grounds promptly once children have been collected at 3.15pm.
