Rota Kids Craft Sale and Scholastic Book Fair

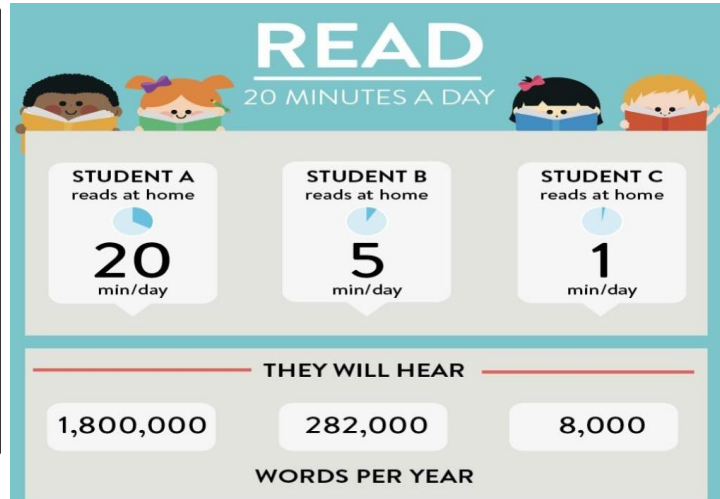
A huge thank you to everyone who supported the Christmas Book Fair. We have raised a fantastic £206.52 to spend on books for our school!

Poetry Corner

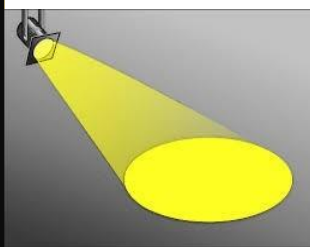
Have fun reciting this short poem with your child. It will even help them in maths too!

Bookmarks**

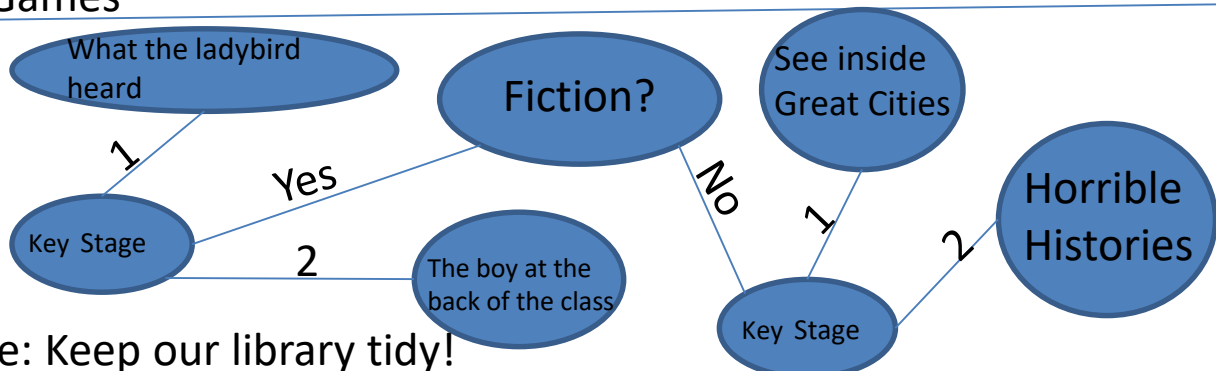

Inferences can be made at any point in the story and are typically based around what characters do or say.

- ⇒ How do you think the character is feeling?
- ⇒ How do you know?
- ⇒ What does the word _____ tell you?
- ⇒ Which character would you most like to meet? Why?
- ⇒ What do you think _____ means?

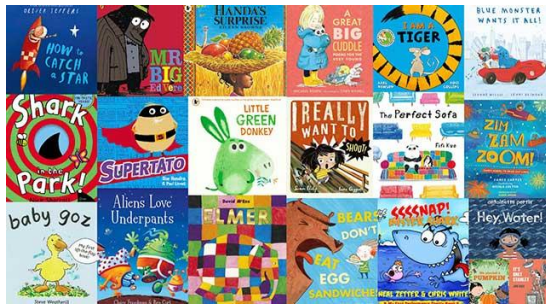
Have a go at our pyjama themed book quiz...
